Parents desirous of withdrawing their ward from school must give one month's notice for the students before the actual withdrawl. No school leaving certificates will be issued from 15th December, 2022 to 1st March, 2023. Written requests for school leaving certificates should be made before 15th of December, 2022, in addition to intimation through the Retention Form
