	"The Chairman satisfied him by stating that let us not bring down the standard of quality of education of the school. It is not possible to maintain the standard by less than 8 % fee hike. As it is your own will for better education that you put your wards in Public Schools. If the school, was wrong it would not have maintained the best student classroom ratio of 30 to maximum 39 students in a classroom. We could have easily taken in more students in each class to make up for the loss.

In this age of inflation the school also has to meet and balance various expenses like increase in employees' salaries, maintenance etc. The Government employees also give a raise of 2-5% Dearness Allowance depending on the government.

"8. The Chairman concluded that if the Standard of the school has to be maintained then the fee hike of just 10% set by the Education Department as per their Rules and Regulations. He further pointed out that we have maintained number of about 30-35 students in each class, which is convenient for the teacher to handle. We do not encourage our children to go for tuitions. The teachers of our school are dedicated and take extra time also to teach the concepts to the students."

The break up analysis of FEE HIKE of last four years is on the slide in the presentation.

From this it can be vividly stated that In the session 2020 there was no hike in the fee subsequently for past two years after Covid 19 Auckland House School had maintained a fee hike of 7.9 % on the request of the parents and keeping in mind the post pandemic conditions.

Now in 2023 the school proposes a fee hike of Rs. 380 per month which will be Rs. 12.67 per day which comes to approximately 10%, which in today's day seems to be affordable and reasonable. A difference of only Rs 70 per month or of Rs 2.33 per day with an increase of additional 2%.
